The Bradford RadLibCamp was fully self financing (and were financed by donations from attendees on the day) and because you're a generous lot the following is true:

- We took £183.50 in donations
- We spent as a collective £100 on room hire at the <u>Bradford Resource Centre</u>
- This means that there is already a RadLibCamp kitty of £83.50 for either the next RadLibCamp or whatever else we as a network of people see fit to decide to do with it...

From the <u>Bradford Feedback</u> it kinds sounded like people wanted another RadLibCamp... so there's a bit of cash there for getting that ball rolling... feel free to get in touch... some of the Bradford collective probably want to be involved BUT:

- we are no experts in how its done...
- we just thought we'd have a go....

all we ask is that in the spirit of RadLibCamp if you do it: you do it so it can be self funded, you do it so its inclusive, and you DO IT!
